

### Format

- 2 half day sessions per week
  - 8:30-11:30am and 12:30-3:30pm
- 12 campers & 2 staff per session
- 6 weeks of camp for a total of 12 sessions

### Set up

- Meadow will be primary staging ground for start and finish of camp day
- Drive through drop off in Walnut grove parking area
- Weather permitting all activities for the day will take place outdoors

### Safety considerations

- Masks must be worn at all times unless eating or drinking
- Individual supply kits will be provided for craft activities and sanitized before re-use
- Campers will be socially distanced during games, crafts and activities
- One in, one out for bathroom use
- Parents will be asked to apply sunscreen and insect repellent prior to drop off (individual packets will be available in necessary to apply it onsite)
- Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the session before/after each activity
- Parents will be asked to take camper's temperature prior to drop-off
- Each camper will bring daily: backpack containing filled water bottle and snack. All items will be taken home daily, and not left on site
- All areas and supplies used will be sanitized between sessions and at the end of each day

### Weather plan-If weather is rainy/stormy and we are forced indoors

- Parents will be notified one hour prior to start time that camp will be at least partially indoors for the day, at this time they can determine if they want their child to participate for the day.
- Drop off for indoor days will require parents to park and accompany child to Nature Center (drop off procedures will be outlined at time of registration)
- Prior to camp session parents will be encouraged to dress campers for rain play on these days
- We will have indoor specific activities planned for these days, which can be done practicing social distancing.
- As long as there is no lightning and rain is not torrential activities may take place in outdoor spaces (covered and non-covered)
